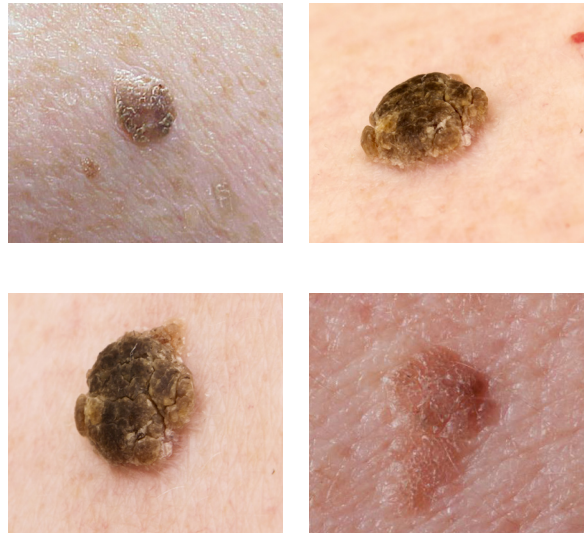


# Clinical Study Participation Opportunity

If you answered yes and are 18 or older, you may be able to participate in a **Seborrheic Keratosis** research study. Zel Skin & Laser Specialists is seeking adults who have at least 4 growths and are interested in having them removed.

As part of the study, qualified participants will receive free study-related skin exams and will be compensated for time and travel. Six visits over a 106-day period are required.



**Seborrheic keratosis** is a common benign (not cancer) skin growth which often starts as small, rough bumps. Then they slowly thicken and get a warty surface. They range in color from white to black, and most are tan or brown.
